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CURRENT APR-AUG FORECASTS AND FLOOD RISK OBJECTIVES

- The Libby Dam February forecast & operations
 - 6.8 MAF or 115% of average
 - FRM Target 2387.7 ft
 - Current elevation is 2386.9 ft
- March projected forecast and operations:
 - 7.2 MAF or 122% of average
 - Current RFC ESP Median trace 6.3 MAF or 108% of average
 - FRM Target ~2362 ft





SNOWPACK CONDITIONS

East Creek SWE % of Ave 2018 113% 2011 104% - 7.7 MAF 2012 102% - 9.2 MAF 2017 100% - 7.1 MAF


