Subject: TMT Notification - Update on Little Goose ASW Operation

Good afternoon TMT,

Following up on today's TMT conference call, the Corps will continue the operation to close the Little Goose adjustable spillway weir (ASW) and shift to the Uniform No ASW pattern in the 2018 Fish Passage Plan Table LGS-10 daily from 4am-4pm through Wednesday, August 1, as recommended by NOAA Fisheries and Idaho. The intent of this operation is to improve Little Goose tailrace hydraulic conditions for endangered adult Snake River sockeye as they migrate upstream. The Corps will re-open the ASW per the spill pattern in FPP Table LGS-8 each day from 4pm-4am to provide surface passage for threatened juvenile Snake River fall Chinook.

As discussed, the ASW will be closed for the remainder of the season per FPP criteria on or after August 1 at 0001 hours when flows are below 35 kcfs and forecasted to stay below 35 kcfs for at least three days.

This operation will be on the agenda for next week's in-person TMT meeting on Wednesday, August 1.
