Subject: Official TMT Coordination: Lower Monumental Dam Spill Pattern

TMT Members and Alternates,

At Lower Monumental Dam (LMN), since the start of summer spill operations (June 21 at 0001 hours) until today (June 28 at 1200 hours) the Corps was not spilling in accordance with the correct spill pattern due to human error. During this period the Corps was spilling in accordance with spill pattern, "Table LMN-8. Uniform Spill Patterns with RSW," when the Corps should have been spilling in accordance with, "Table LMN-7. Bulk Spill Pattern with RSW." The Corps discovered this error today and at 1200 hours LMN began spilling in accordance with "Table LMN-7. Bulk Spill Pattern with RSW." The Corps will continue operating LMN spill patterns as described in 2019 Fish Passage Plan (2019 FPP) through the end of summer spill operations on August 31, at 2359 hours.
