Subject: Official TMT Coordination: Little Goose Dam Spill Pattern Change

TMT Members and Alternates,

At Little Goose Dam (LGS), effective today through the remainder of the summer spill operation (August 31) the Adjustable Spillway Weir (ASW) will be closed and the Corps will spill in accordance with spill pattern, "Table LGS-10, Uniform Spill Patterns for 30% Spill with No Adjustable Spillway Weir (Bay 1 Closed)." The Corps closed the ASW based on the recommendation from FPAC in order to improve LGS tailrace hydraulics for juvenile and adult salmon. Closing the ASW today is prior to the date (August 1) described in the 2019 Fish Passage Plan (2019 FPP).
