

Official TMT Coordination: Lower Monumental Forebay Adjustment

April 4, 2020

Beginning today, April 4, the Corps raised the Lower Monumental Dam Minimum Operating Pool (MOP) range by a half-foot for the purpose of navigation safety. The 0.5-foot raised MOP (537.5-539.0 feet) adjustment at Lower Monumental Dam was made to maintain the minimum depth at the downstream entrance to the navigation lock at Little Goose Dam. This operation is discussed in greater detail in the 2020 Fish Operations Plan in section 4.6 Navigation Safety. Lower Monumental will be operated within the 0.5-foot raised MOP range for navigation safety until further notice.

Official TMT Coordination: Little Goose Forebay Adjustment

Beginning today, April 7, the Corps raised the Little Goose Dam Minimum Operating Pool (MOP) range by a half-foot for the purpose of navigation safety. The 0.5-foot raised MOP (633.5-635.0 feet) adjustment at Little Goose Dam was made to maintain the minimum depth at the downstream entrance to the navigation lock at Lower Granite Dam. This operation is discussed in greater detail in the 2020 Fish Operations Plan in section 4.6 Navigation Safety. Little Goose will be operated within the 0.5-foot raised MOP range for navigation safety until further notice.
