**Table 4.** Collection of adult Pacific lamprey at USACE dams for tribal studies and restoration activities in 2012. Capture locations include BON traps, Cascades Island LPS, TDA traps, JDA traps, and ladder dewatering sites. Tribal allocation guidelines were 80/tribe at BON, 168/tribe at TDA, and 138/tribe at JDA. The CTUIR, YN, and NPT shared collection efforts in 2012, so numbers below may not accurately reflect totals retained by each tribe.
