## MEMORANDUM FOR THE RECORD: 21 LGS 05 Tailrace Inspection Results

## **SUBJECT: Tailrace Juvenile Mortalities**

## Background

Following rumors that dead fish were seen along the tailrace bank of Little Goose Dam during the 2020 spring migration and spill season, project biologists were asked to look for such occurrences during 2021. Starting April 1, in conjunction with bird counts, Juvenile Fish Facility staff began surveying the tailrace north shore as they are able with current responsibilities for JFF collection and transport operations.

The first dead salmonids were seen on 1 May and numbers since have ranged from 0 to 9 dead fish per day. The table below summarizes findings to date. Currently the cause of death is undetermined. Biologists will continue to survey the tailrace and collect fish for inspection.
