SUBJECT: 22BON019 MFR LFS Early Shut Down

On the afternoon of Thursday 16 June, the Lamprey Flume Structure (LFS) trap located on the North Monolith of the Washington Shore Fishway was shut down for the season. No fish were recovered. The Corps-Tribal Lamprey Workgroup had a quarterly meeting on the afternoon of Wednesday, June 15th and voted to shut down the LFS for the safety of the lamprey and to prevent further damage to the structure. These actions were taken after finding a “geyser” coming out of one of the upward facing hatches which resulted in at least three lamprey mortalities.
