**Location of Change-** Appendix G BON AFF trapping protocols 4.

*Trapping will not occur when fish ladder water temperatures meet or exceed 70°F as measured in the brail pool. The only exception is for US v Oregon requirements.*

**Proposed Change:**

Allow lamprey trapping when water temps are between 70°F and 72°F

*Salmonid trapping will not occur when fish ladder water temperatures meet or exceed 70°F as measured in the brail pool. The only exception is for US v Oregon requirements and for nighttime lamprey trapping.*

**Reason for Change:**

According to lamprey researchers, handling lamprey at the elevated temperatures does not seem to stress them as it does salmonids.

**Comments from others:**

NOAA and USFWS are OK with the trapping.

CRITFC is ok but would like to see trapping reduced to four nights a week.

IDFG is mulled over the issue and decided it was OK.

ODFW is unavailable.

WDFW was left a voice message but no return call yet.
