### Proposed Change:

**2.2.3. Adult Fish.** ~~During the primary adult fish passage period (March 01 through November 01 through August~~, daytime spill will be limited to less than 100 kcfs 75 kcfs from July 01 through August whenever powerhouse one is in operation possible (see also 2.2.2.). Normally, this restriction will be from one hour before sunrise to one half hour after sunset (Table BON-5). However, during that portion of the sockeye run that occurs between July 01 June 16 and through August July 15, the cap will apply until one hour after sunset only when powerhouse one is in operation.<sup>[GLF1]</sup>

**Reason for Change:** This section needs to be updated. We long ago found that adults were minimally effected by spill levels at or below the current daytime levels of 85 to 100 kcfs. Also, this restriction was impemented to protect fallback adults, however, we have since learned that when powerhouse one is not operating few adults fall back. The restriction beyond July 15 is unnecessary since sockeye numbers historically drop dramatically after this date and the number passing at night would be very low.
