

MEMORANDUM FOR THE RECORD

SUBJECT: 13BON15 MFR – Pacific Lamprey mortalities at Bonneville’s Washington Shore LFS/LPS.

On 15 June 2013, University of Idaho researchers contacted Project Fisheries to report that a number of mortalities had been observed while netting fish from the newly constructed Washington Shore LFS/LPS (Rest Box #2). The fish were observed along with 9 additional live pacific lamprey. Mortalities were brought into the AFF for measurements and scanned for pit tags. Mortalities were released into valve 15 return pool drain once data was collected. Information collected is provided below:

- A. Species – Pacific Lamprey (*Entosphenus tridentatus*).
- B. Origin – Unknown.
- C. Length – 61 & 65 cm.
- D. Marks and tags – None.
- E. Marks and Injuries found on carcass – No marks or injuries observed. These fish had not been sampled either.
- F. Cause and Time of Death – Unknown.
- G. Future and Preventative Measures – Not applicable.
