

MEMORANDUM FOR THE RECORD

SUBJECT: Lamprey mortalities at Bonneville's Washington Shore Adult Fish Facility (AFF).

On 18 June at 0900 Bonneville Project Biologists recovered one dead Pacific lamprey from the valve 15 trash rack in the AFF. The fish was discovered during a partial dewatering of the AFF in preparation for work to remove the downstream section of the bypass flumes. The fish was not PIT tagged. Information is provided below:

- A. Species – Pacific lamprey (*Entosphenus tridentatus*)
- B. Origin – Unknown.
- C. Length – 62 cm.
- D. Marks and tags – None.
- E. Marks and Injuries found on carcass – No notable marks or injuries.
- F. Cause and Time of Death – Unknown.
- G. Future and Preventative Measures – None.
