SUBJECT: 13BON20 MFR - Chinook Salmon jack and Pacific Lamprey mortality at Bonneville's Adult Fish Facility (AFF)

On 21 June 2013, CRITFC & University of Idaho researchers contacted Project Fisheries to report that mortalities had been observed. The fish were observed on the valve 15 trash rack. Information collected is provided below:

- A. Species – Chinook Jack (*Oncorhynchus tshawytscha*).
- B. Origin – Hatchery (adipose clipped).
- C. Length – 51 cm.
- D. Marks and tags – PIT: 3D9.1C2DF28701.
- E. Marks and Injuries found on carcass – No notable marks or injuries.
- F. Cause and Time of Death – Unknown.
- G. Future and Preventative Measures – Not applicable.
