

**MEMORANDUM FOR THE RECORD**

**SUBJECT: 13BON42 MFR** – Chinook Salmon mortality at Bonneville’s Adult Fish Facility (AFF).

On 15 July 2013, University of ID researchers contacted Project Fisheries to report that a sampling mortality had been observed at their release site. Upon releasing their tagged fish back to the river, one Chinook was deceased. It was collected and brought back to the AFF. Information collected is provided below:

- A. Species – Chinook Salmon (*Oncorhynchus tshawytscha*).
- B. Origin – Hatchery (adipose clipped).
- C. Length – 67 cm.
- D. Marks and tags – Fish had been tagged the morning of 15 July.
- E. Marks and Injuries found on carcass – No notable marks or injuries.
- F. Cause and Time of Death – Unknown.
- G. Future and Preventative Measures – Not applicable.
