

MEMORANDUM FOR THE RECORD

SUBJECT: 13BON50 MFR – Pacific Lamprey mortality at Bonneville’s Adult Fish Facility (AFF) and in the Cascades Island (CI) serpentine section.

On 24 July 2013, CRITFC researchers contacted Project Fisheries to report that two Pacific Lamprey mortalities were recovered from the valve 15 trash rack in the AFF. The fish were in advanced state of decomposition, therefore no length measurements were taken. In addition, three Pacific Lamprey mortalities were discovered by a Project Biologist in the Cascades Island serpentine section, which is currently not in use.

Information collected is provided below:

- A. Species – Pacific Lamprey (*Entosphenus tridentatus*).
- B. Origin – Unknown.
- C. Length – Unknown.
- D. Marks and tags – None.
- E. Marks and Injuries found on carcass – No noticeable marks or injuries.
- F. Cause and Time of Death – Unknown.
- G. Future and Preventative Measures – Not applicable.
