

**MEMORANDUM FOR THE RECORD**

**SUBJECT: 13BON57 MFR** – Pacific Lamprey mortality at Bonneville’s Adult Fish Facility (AFF).

On 03 August 2013, University of Idaho personnel contacted Project Fisheries to report a single Pacific Lamprey mortality. The fish was observed outside on the lower picket lead catwalk. It appeared as if the fish had possibly been attempting to pass the picket leads when they were raised after sampling on a much earlier date. The fish was completely dry and baked from the sun.

Information collected is provided below:

- A. Species – Pacific Lamprey (*Entosphenus tridentatus*).
- B. Origin – Unknown.
- C. Length – 58 cm.
- D. Marks and tags – None.
- E. Marks and Injuries found on carcass – No additional marks / injuries not scene in picture.
- F. Cause and Time of Death – Unknown.
- G. Future and Preventative Measures – None / Unknown.
