SUBJECT: 13BON60 MFR – Chinook Salmon mini jack mortality at Bonneville's Adult Fish Facility (AFF).

On 14 August 2013, CRITFC personnel contacted Project Fisheries to report a Chinook Salmon mini jack mortality collected from the flume above the anesthetic tank.

- A. Species Chinook salmon (Oncorhynchus tshawytscha).
- B. Origin Unknown (adipose clipped).
- C. Length 26.5 cm.
- D. Marks and tags None.
- E. Marks and Injuries found on carcass None.
- F. Cause and Time of Death Cause is likely being trapped in flume unbeknownst to the researchers running the AFF.
- G. Future and Preventative Measures Short term: better communication between switchgate operator and fish handlers. If a smolt/mini jack is directed down the sample flume, they need to communicate to insure it reaches the tank. Long term: modify flap within sample flume to allow smolts/mini jacks to pass under it.
