

MEMORANDUM FOR THE RECORD

SUBJECT: 13BON61 MFR – Chinook mortality at Bonneville’s Adult Fish Facility (AFF).

On 19 August 2013, a Project Biologist discovered a dead Chinook floating in the AFF return pool downstream of the baffle. The fish was in a decomposed state and had a large visible wound on the right lateral side.

Information collected is provided below:

- A. Species – Chinook salmon (*Oncorhynchus tshawytscha*).
- B. Origin – Unclipped.
- C. Length – 81 cm.
- D. Marks and tags – PIT 384.3B23AE0347.
- E. Marks and Injuries found on carcass – Wound in the right side with intestines coming through the body cavity.
- F. Cause and Time of Death – Unknown.
- G. Future and Preventative Measures – Not applicable.
