

MEMORANDUM FOR THE RECORD

SUBJECT: 13BON64 MFR – Chinook Salmon Jack mortality at BON Adult Fish Facility (AFF) and Pacific Lamprey mortality at Bradford Island.

On 28 August 2013, CRITFC personnel contacted Project Fisheries to report a Chinook Salmon mortality from the AFF brail pool. The fish was a sampled fish. Also, NOAA researchers alerted Project Fisheries of a Pacific Lamprey mortality in the lower-most Bradford Island serpentine section overflow slot between the ladder and AWS channel. The lamprey was severely decomposed and no picture of it is provided.
