

**MEMORANDUM FOR THE RECORD**

**SUBJECT: 14BON10 MFR** – Chinook salmon mortality at Bonneville’s Adult Fish Facility (AFF).

On 12 May 2014, University of Idaho personnel contacted Project Fisheries to report a Chinook salmon mortality on the valve 15 trash rack. The fish was not seen prior to placing the facility in sample mode; it is possible that the fish floated in during sampling. Due to the compromised condition of the fish, it is unknown if the fish had an adipose clip or not. Information collected is provided below:

- A. Species – Chinook salmon (*Oncorhynchus tshawytscha*).
- B. Origin – Unknown.
- C. Length – 59.5 cm.
- D. Marks and tags – No tags, clip unable to be determined.
- E. Marks and Injuries found on carcass – Unknown; fish was severely decomposed.
- F. Cause and Time of Death – Unknown.
- G. Future and Preventative Measures – Unknown.
