

**MEMORANDUM FOR THE RECORD**

**SUBJECT: 14BON17 MFR** – Yearling Chinook Salmon mortality at Bonneville’s Adult Fish Facility (AFF).

On 25 June 2014, University of Idaho researchers contacted Project Fisheries to report a yearling Chinook salmon mortality. The fish was found dead in the AFF lamprey trap. The fish was also clipped. This fish was kept for bio-analysis by USFWS in conjunction with the USGS and CRITFC.

Information collected is provided below:

- A. Species –Chinook salmon (*Oncorhynchus tshawytscha*).
- B. Origin – Hatchery. Adipose clipped.
- C. Length – Unknown.
- D. Marks and tags – No visible marks or tags (besides adipose clipped).
- E. Marks and Injuries found on carcass – No visible marks or injuries were found.
- F. Cause and Time of Death – Unknown. Likely during the night between 24 and 25 June.
- G. Future and Preventative Measures – Unknown.
