

**MEMORANDUM FOR THE RECORD**

**SUBJECT: 14BON24 MFR** – Chinook mortality at Bonneville’s Adult Fish Facility (AFF).

On 02 July 2014, a CRITFC researcher contacted Project Fisheries to report a Chinook salmon mortality recovered from the valve 15 trash rack. The fish was seen swimming lethargically earlier in the day. The fish was kept for bio-analysis by USFWS in conjunction with the USGS and CRITFC.

Information collected is provided below:

- A. Species – Chinook salmon (*Oncorhynchus tshawytscha*)
- B. Origin – Unknown, no clip
- C. Length – 82 cm
- D. Marks and tags – No marks or tags
- E. Marks and Injuries found on carcass – No visible marks or injuries
- F. Cause and Time of Death – Died ~noon on 02 July, cause unknown
- G. Future and Preventative Measures – Unknown
