

MEMORANDUM FOR THE RECORD

SUBJECT: 14BON33 MFR – Pacific Lamprey Mortality at Bonneville’s Washington Shore LPS.

On 11 July NOAA personnel informed project biologists that a Pacific Lamprey mortality had been observed in one of the Washington Shore LPS rest boxes. NOAA personnel brought the fish back to the AFF so that project biologists could inspect and document the mortality. The Pacific Lamprey was kept for bio-analysis by USFWS in conjunction with the USGS and CRITFC.

Information collected is provided below:

- A. Species – Pacific Lamprey (*Entosphenus tridentatus*).
- B. Origin – Unknown.
- C. Length – 68 cm.
- D. Marks and tags – No marks and/or tags were present.
- E. Marks and Injuries found on carcass – No marks and/or injuries were found on the carcass.
- F. Cause and Time of Death – Unknown.
- G. Future and Preventative Measures – Unknown.
