

**MEMORANDUM FOR THE RECORD****SUBJECT: 14BON35 MFR** – Pacific Lamprey at Bonneville’s Adult Fish Facility (AFF).

On 16 July 2014, University of Idaho researchers contacted Project Fisheries to report six Pacific Lamprey mortalities. These fish were found on the valve 15 trash rack. These fish were saved for bio-analysis by USFWS in conjunction with the USGS and CRITFC.

Information collected is provided below:

- A. Species – Pacific Lamprey (*Entosphenus tridentatus*).
- B. Origin – Unknown.
- C. Length –57, 58, 60.5, 63, 67.5, & 69 cm.
- D. Marks and tags – No marks and/or tags were present.
- E. Marks and Injuries found on carcass – No visible marks or injuries.
- F. Cause and Time of Death – Unknown (most fish were in an advanced state of decay).
- G. Future and Preventative Measures – Unknown.
