

**MEMORANDUM FOR THE RECORD**

**SUBJECT: 14BON41 MFR** – Chinook mortality at Bonneville's Adult Fish Facility (AFF).

On 21 July 2014, U of I researchers contacted Project Fisheries to report a Chinook salmon mortality recovered from the valve 15 trash rack. The fish was in a deteriorated condition. The fish was kept for bio-analysis by USFWS in conjunction with the USGS and CRITFC.

- B. Origin – Unknown, Adipose clipped
- C. Length – 73 cm
