

MEMORANDUM FOR THE RECORD

SUBJECT: 14BON62 MFR – Chinook Salmon mortality at Bonneville’s Adult Fish Facility (AFF).

On 06 September 2014, University of Idaho researchers contacted Project Fisheries to report a Chinook mortality. This fish was a CRITFC sampled fish. It was found parallel to the brail pool early in the morning of 06 September. U of I personnel found a CRITFC mortality incident sheet documenting the mortality. The fish was saved for bio-analysis by USFWS in conjunction with the USGS and CRITFC.

Information collected is provided below:

- A. Species – Chinook salmon (*Oncorhynchus tshawytscha*).
- B. Origin – Unknown – wild.
- C. Sex – Male.
- D. Length –92 cm.
- E. Marks and tags – PIT: 3DD.00773B6D49.
- F. Marks and Injuries found on carcass – No marks and/or injuries were observed.
- G. Cause and Time of Death – Unknown.
- H. Future and Preventative Measures – None.
