

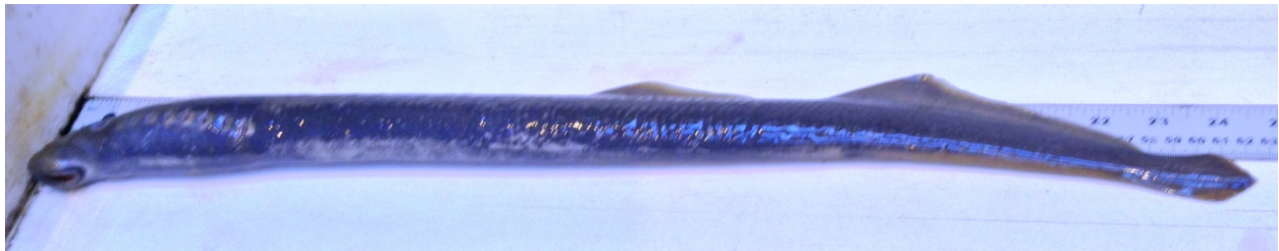
**MEMORANDUM FOR THE RECORD**

**SUBJECT: 14BON74 MFR** – Pacific Lamprey mortality from the Cascades Island Auxiliary Water Supply (AWS) Pacific Lamprey trap.

On 24 September 2014, NOAA researchers contacted Project Fisheries to report a Pacific Lamprey mortality recovered from the Cascades Island AWS lamprey traps. The fish was not PIT tagged. The fish was saved for bio-analysis by USFWS in conjunction with the USGS and CRITFC.

Information collected is provided below:

- A. Species – Pacific Lamprey (*Entosphenus tridentatus*).
- B. Origin – Unknown.
- C. Length – 62 cm.
- D. Marks and tags – No marks and/or tags were observed.
- E. Marks and Injuries found on carcass – No marks and/or injuries were observed.
- F. Cause and Time of Death – Unknown.
- G. Future and Preventative Measures – Unknown.
