

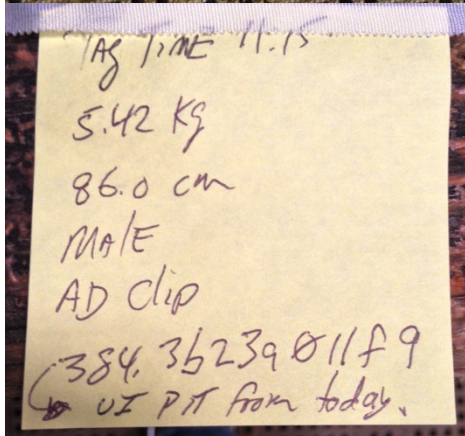
MEMORANDUM FOR THE RECORD

SUBJECT: 14BON75 MFR – Steelhead mortality at Bonneville's Adult Fish Facility (AFF).

On 25 September 2014, University of Idaho researchers contacted Project Fisheries to report a Steelhead mortality. This fish had been sampled by University of Idaho personnel. After being sampled, the fish was placed into U of I's recovery / transportation tank. Observations indicated the fish had not recovered and was then placed into CRITFC's auxiliary recovery tank. U of I personnel made attempts to assist the fish in recovery, but were unsuccessful. The fish was saved for bio-analysis by USFWS in conjunction with the USGS and CRITFC.

Information collected is provided below:

- A. Species – Steelhead (*Oncorhynchus mykiss*).
- B. Origin – Hatchery.
- C. Length – 86 cm.
- D. Weight – 5.42 kg.
- E. Sex – Male.
- F. Marks and tags – Adipose-Clipped, PIT: 384.3B239011F9, previously radio-tagged. No record in PITAGIS.
- G. Marks and Injuries found on carcass – No marks and/or injuries were observed.
- H. Cause and Time of Death – ~1115 on 25 September 2014.
- I. Future and Preventative Measures – University of Idaho researchers will continue to handle fish with care and monitor recovery.
