

**MEMORANDUM FOR THE RECORD**

**SUBJECT: 14BON79 MFR** – Coho Salmon and unidentified salmonid mortality at Bonneville's Adult Fish Facility (AFF).

On 14 October 2014, CRITFC and UI researchers contacted Project Fisheries to report two adult salmonid mortalities recovered from the valve 15 trash rack. One was a Coho Salmon, the second fish was a jack-sized salmonid. Due to decomposition, the species of the second fish was not able to be identified.

Information collected is provided below:

- A. Species – Coho Salmon (*Oncorhynchus kisutch*), one unidentified
- B. Origin – COH: unclipped, Unidentified fish: clipped
- C. Length – COH: 58 cm, Unidentified fish: 36 cm
- D. Marks and tags – None
- E. Marks and Injuries found on carcass – None
- F. Cause and Time of Death – Unknown
- G. Future and Preventative Measures – Efforts to decrease the number of mortalities recovered in the AFF are ongoing.
