

**MEMORANDUM FOR THE RECORD**

**SUBJECT: 15BON18 MFR** – Chinook mortality at Bonneville’s Adult Fish Facility (AFF).

On 19 June 2015, a CRITFC researcher contacted Project Fisheries to report two juvenile Chinook Salmon mortalities recovered from the lamprey traps. The fish were returned to the river.

Information collected is provided below:

- A. Species – Chinook Salmon (*Oncorhynchus tshawytscha*)
- B. Origin – One clipped, one not clipped
- C. Length – 23 cm
- D. Marks and tags – One fin clipped
- E. Marks and Injuries found on carcass – No visible marks or injuries
- F. Cause and Time of Death – Stress/smothering, morning of 19 June.
- G. Future and Preventative Measures – None
