SUBJECT: 15BON30 MFR – Pacific Lamprey Mortality on the Washington shore AWS LPS grating

On 29 June 2015, Corps biologists from the Fish Field Unit discovered a dead Pacific Lamprey on the grating directly in front of the entrance ramps of the WA shore AWS LPS. It's unknown how the fish came to be on the grating; possibilities include a bird dropping the lamprey, or the fish itself flopping out of the LPS channel.
