

**MEMORANDUM FOR THE RECORD**

**SUBJECT: 15BON30 MFR – Pacific Lamprey Mortality on the Washington shore AWS LPS grating**

On 29 June 2015, Corps biologists from the Fish Field Unit discovered a dead Pacific Lamprey on the grating directly in front of the entrance ramps of the WA shore AWS LPS. It's unknown how the fish came to be on the grating; possibilities include a bird dropping the lamprey, or the fish itself flopping out of the LPS channel.

Information collected is provided below:

- A. Species – Pacific Lamprey (*Entosphenus tridentatus*).
- B. Origin – Unknown.
- C. Length – 74 cm.
- D. Marks and tags – No marks or tags were observed.
- E. Marks and Injuries found on carcass – No visible marks or injuries were observed.
- F. Cause and Time of Death – Unknown.
- G. Future and Preventative Measures – None.
