

MEMORANDUM FOR THE RECORD

SUBJECT: 15BON36 MFR – Pacific Lamprey and Sockeye Salmon mortalities at Bonneville’s Adult Fish Facility (AFF).

On 02 July 2015, CRITFC personnel contacted project fisheries about (5) Pacific Lamprey and (1) Sockeye Salmon mortalities. These fish were found on the valve 15 trashrack. After collecting data, the fish were returned to the river via the valve 15 discharge.

Information collected is provided below:

- A. Species – Sockeye Salmon (*Oncorhynchus nerka*).
 - B. Origin – Unknown, adipose present.
 - C. Length – 53 cm.
 - D. Marks and tags – None.
 - E. Marks and Injuries found on carcass – Small gouge on both sides of belly.
 - F. Cause and Time of Death – Unknown.
 - G. Future and Preventative Measures – None.

- A. Species – Pacific Lamprey (*Entosphenus tridentatus*).
 - B. Origin – Unknown. Chinook was clipped.
 - C. Length – 60, 61, 67, 69, 76 cm.
 - D. Marks and tags – No marks or tags were observed.
 - E. Marks and Injuries found on carcass – No visible marks or injuries were observed.
 - F. Cause and Time of Death – Unknown.
 - G. Future and Preventative Measures – None.
