SUBJECT: 15BON43 MFR – Pacific Lamprey and Sockeye Salmon mortalities at Bonneville’s Adult Fish Facility (AFF).

On the afternoon of 08 July 2015, Project Fisheries recovered one Pacific Lamprey and three Sockeye Salmon mortalities from the valve 15 trash rack in the AFF. All fish were returned to the river.

- A. Species – Sockeye Salmon (*Oncorhynchus nerka*)
- B. Origin – Unknown, adipose present on all fish.
- C. Lengths – 48, 48, 51 cm
- D. Marks and tags – No marks and/or tags were observed.
