

MEMORANDUM FOR THE RECORD

SUBJECT: 15BON78 MFR –Salmonid mortalities at Bonneville’s AFF.

On 11 September 2015, Project Biologists recovered one Chinook from the AFF valve 15 trash rack. The fish had an injury to the right ventral side, just ahead of the pelvic fin, which appeared to be a sea lion bite. The fish had no tags and was returned to the river.

Information collected is provided below:

- A. Species – Chinook (*Oncorhynchus tshawytscha*)
- B. Origin – Unknown
- C. Lengths – 79 cm
- D. Tags – None
- E. Marks and Injuries found on carcass – Injury on right ventral side.
- F. Cause and Time of Death – Assumed to be injury related.
- G. Future and Preventative Measures – None
