**SUBJECT: 16BON106 MFR** – Chinook salmon mortalities at Bonneville’s Adult Fish Facility (AFF).

On 25 August, CRITFC researchers alerted Project Fisheries of an adult and mini-jack Chinook Salmon found on the valve 15 trash track within the AFF. Both fish were returned to the river after documentation.

- B. Origin – Unknown, adipose present.
- C. Length – 77 cm.
- D. Marks and tags – No marks and/or tags observed.
