

MEMORANDUM FOR THE RECORD

SUBJECT: 16BON15 MFR – Chinook and Lamprey mortalities at Bonneville’s Adult Fish Facility (AFF).

On 31 May, CRITFC researchers contacted Project Fisheries to report one Chinook Salmon and three Pacific Lamprey mortalities recovered from the valve 15 trash rack. All but one lamprey were in an advanced state of decomposition and no fish had any tags.

Information collected is provided below:

- A. Species – Chinook Salmon (*Oncorhynchus tshawytscha*) and Pacific Lamprey (*Entosphenus tridentatus*)
- B. Origin – CHK: No adipose visible but presence unknown due to degradation
- C. Length – CHK: 77 cm
PL (top of photo to bottom): 52, 65, and 58 cm
- D. Marks and tags – No marks or tags
- E. Marks and Injuries found on carcass – No visible marks or injuries
- F. Cause and Time of Death – Unknown
- G. Future and Preventative Measures – None
