

**MEMORANDUM FOR THE RECORD**

**SUBJECT: 16BON33 MFR** – Adult Pacific Lamprey mortality at Cascades Island LPS.

On 15 June, Fish Field Unit biologists alerted Project Fisheries that a Pacific Lamprey mortality was found in the transition area below the exit pipe (“the pond”) of the Cascades Island LPS. The lamprey was saved for later analysis. The information they collected is provided below:



- A. Species – Pacific Lamprey (*Entosphenus tridentatus*).
- B. Origin – Unknown
- C. Length – 52 cm (interdorsal length 26 mm)
- D. Marks and tags – Not checked
- E. Marks and Injuries found on carcass – Unknown
- F. Cause and Time of Death – Unknown
- G. Future and Preventative Measures – None
