MEMORANDUM FOR THE RECORD

SUBJECT: 16BON34 MFR - Adult Pacific Lamprey mortalities at Bonneville's WA shore count station crowder.

On 15 June 2016, Project Fisheries found 4 Pacific Lamprey mortalities on the picket leads behind the WA shore count station crowder. The fish were largely decomposing, were not checked for tags or measured, and were returned to the river. The information they collected is provided below:

- A. Species – Pacific lamprey (*Entosphenus tridentatus*)
- B. Origin – Unknown
- C. Length – 60-75 cm
- D. Marks and Tags – Unknown
- E. Marks and injuries found on carcass – None
- F. Cause and Time of Death – Unknown
- G. Future and Preventative Measures – Attempting to trap Lamprey out of area.
