

MEMORANDUM FOR THE RECORD

SUBJECT: 16BON43 MFR – Adult Pacific Lamprey mortality at Cascades Island lamprey passage system (LPS).

On 22 June, a Fish Field Unit biologist alerted Project Fisheries that a Pacific Lamprey mortality was found in the transition area below the exit pipe (“the pond”) of the Cascades Island LPS. The fish was scanned and no PIT tags were found. The fish were saved for researcher analysis. The information they collected is provided below:

- A. Species – Pacific Lamprey (*Entosphenus tridentatus*).
- B. Origin – Unknown
- C. Length – 56.5 cm (interdorsal length 27 mm)
- D. Marks and tags – None
- E. Marks and Injuries found on carcass – Unknown
- F. Cause and Time of Death – Unknown
- G. Future and Preventative Measures – None
