

**MEMORANDUM FOR THE RECORD**

**SUBJECT: 16BON90 MFR** – Steelhead Trout mortality at Bonneville’s Adult Fish Facility (AFF).

On 03 August 2016, Bonneville Project Fisheries was alerted of a Steelhead Trout mortality at the AFF. According to CRITFC researcher’s account, the fish was observed bleeding from the gills inside the anesthetic tank. The fish appeared to be otherwise uninjured and healthy. While the fish was not sampled, it was however inspected for PIT tags and measured. The fish was saved for future analysis by USFWS Lower Columbia River Fish Health Center.

Information collected is provided below:

- A. Species – Steelhead Trout (*Oncorhynchus mykiss*).
- B. Origin – Unknown, adipose present.
- C. Length – 56 cm.
- D. Marks and tags – No marks and/or tags present.
- E. Marks and Injuries found on carcass – No marks and/or injuries observed.
- F. Cause and Time of Death – None.
