

MEMORANDUM FOR THE RECORD

SUBJECT: 17BON22 - Pacific Lamprey mortality on the Bradford Island LPS grating.

On the morning of 24 June, Fish Field Unit biologists found an adult Pacific Lamprey mortality from the grating under the BI LPS. The fish may have jumped from the LPS and became stranded on the grating. The mort was released to the river.

- A. Species – Pacific Lamprey (*Entosphenus tridentatus*).
- B. Origin – Unknown.
- C. Length – TL 56 cm.
- D. Marks and tags – No marks and/or tags were observed.
- E. Marks and Injuries found on carcass – No marks and/or injuries were observed.
- F. Cause and Time of Death – Dried out on grating, between 22 and 24 June inspections.
- G. Future and Preventative Measures – We are investigating additional netting in this area to prevent lamprey from leaving the LPS.
