SUBJECT: 17BON47 MFR – Pacific Lamprey Mortalities 10 July 2017 Numerous Locations.

On 10 July, FFU personnel reported (4) Pacific Lamprey mortalities from a number of locations at Bonneville Dam. 2/4 fish were saved for future analysis with USFWS Lower Columbia Fish Health Center.

Species – Pacific lamprey (*Entosphenus tridentatus*).

Origin – Unknown.

Location - RB 1 at the WA Shore -UMT Junction LPS.

Length – 68 cm.

Marks and Tags – No marks and/or tags observed.

Marks and injuries found on carcass – No marks and/or injuries observed.

Cause and Time of Death – Unknown.

Future and Preventative Measures – None.
