

**MEMORANDUM FOR THE RECORD**

**SUBJECT: 17BON48 MFR** – Pacific Lamprey Mortalities found in the AFF.

On 14 July, CRITFC researchers alerted Project Fisheries of (3) Pacific Lamprey mortalities found on valve 15 trash rack throughout the day. Apparently (2) of the morts were from the previous day. Due to a voicemail issue, they were not sampled until 14 July. They were not saved for analysis. The fish found post sampling on the 14<sup>th</sup> was saved for future analysis with USFWS Lower Columbia Fish Health Center.

The information collected is provided below:

Species – Pacific lamprey (*Entosphenus tridentatus*).

Origin – Unknown.

Location – AFF Valve 15 trash rack.

Length – 57, 68, & 70 cm.

Marks and Tags – No marks and/or tags observed.

Marks and injuries found on carcass – No marks and/or injuries observed. See photos.

Cause and Time of Death – Unknown.

Future and Preventative Measures – None.
