SUBJECT: 17BON50 MFR – Two Pacific Lamprey Morts found at rest box #2 at the WA Shore - UMT Junction LPS.

On 16 July, FFU personnel found two Pacific Lamprey mortality at rest box #2 at the WA Shore – UMT Junction Section. Due to the decomposed state of the fish, it was returned to the river after measurements and photographs.

The information collected is provided below:

Species – Pacific lamprey (*Entosphenus tridentatus*).

Origin – Unknown.

Length – 73.5, 60.5 cm.

Marks and Tags – No marks and/or tags observed.

Marks and injuries found on carcass – No marks and/or injuries observed.

Cause and Time of Death – Unknown.

Future and Preventative Measures – None.
