SUBJECT: 17BON58 MFR Pacific Lamprey mortalities from both count station picket leads

On the morning of 26 July, Project Fisheries biologists recovered two Pacific Lamprey mortalities recovered from the picket leads behind the WA shore count station crowder, and approximately 15 from the picket leads behind the Bradford Island count station crowder. The fish were returned to the river after examination.
