

**MEMORANDUM FOR THE RECORD**

**SUBJECT: 17BON63** – Pacific lamprey mortality found at a tribal pot trap on Bradford Island

On Thursday August 17, 2017, a Warm Springs technician and CRITFC biologist found one dead adult lamprey in the pot trap nearest to the catwalk ladder at the Bradford Island fish ladder. It also had white coloring on its underside. The fish was released via the valve 15 return drain.

- A. Species – Pacific lamprey (*Entosphenus tridentatus*)
- B. Origin – wild
- C. Length – 690mm
- D. Marks and tags – none
- E. Marks and Injuries found on carcass – abrasions and scarring from a possible bite
- F. Cause and Time of Death – cause unknown; time between 8/16/17 in the morning and 8/17/17 at 0930.
- G. Future and Preventative Measures – none
