

**MEMORANDUM FOR THE RECORD**

**SUBJECT: 17BON64 MFR - Chinook salmon mortalities at Bonneville's Adult Fish Facility (AFF).**

On 12 September, CRITFC researchers contacted Project Fisheries to report two Chinook salmon mortalities sampled and PIT tagged at the AFF. The larger fish was recovered from the brail pool. The smaller fish did not recover in the recovery tank. Both fish were saved for later analysis by USFWS. Information collected is provided below:

- A. Species – Chinook Salmon (*Oncorhynchus tshawytscha*).
- B. Origin – Large fish: unclipped. Smaller fish: Adipose clipped
- C. Length – 83.5 cm and 77 cm
- D. Marks and tags – Larger fish PIT: 3DD.0077BA9BF0, Smaller fish PIT: 3DD.0077BAAA45
- E. Injuries found on carcass – None.
- F. Cause and Time of Death – Unknown. Sampled fish died ~1120 on 12 September.
- G. Future and Preventative Measures – None.
