**SUBJECT: 18BON13 MFR – Adult Fish Facility Chinook Mortality.**

On the morning of 29 May, CRITFC researchers found a Chinook mortality on the valve 15 trash rack.

- A. Species – Chinook (*Oncorhynchus tshawytscha*).
- B. Origin – Unknown
- C. Length – 69.5 cm
- D. Marks and tags – PIT tag: 3DD.0077BA5BC1. A search of PIT TAGIS database found no data for this number; the reason is most likely that the number has not been uploaded into the database yet.
- E. Marks and Injuries found on carcass – N/A
- F. Cause and Time of Death – Unknown
- G. Future and Preventative Measures – None.

Erin,

Got it. It seems CRITFC should be able to check their own data to see if they had tagged the fish. But if that won't work, it would be helpful if the Corps could provide a summary after the PIT data have been uploaded of morts that were tagged at the AFF and those that weren't. Because of work load and uploading timing, I will leave the appropriate time interval up to the Corps. If you go that route, it is fine if you maintain the current MFR process as you suggested. I just want to make sure we are tracking any issues caused by tagging and handling efforts and keep those separate from any issues with the fish ladder.

Andrew pointed out that there is a lag of about a week before the numbers are uploaded to PIT TAGIS. We are checking to see if the staff at the AFF can look into their own numbers after running the scan. However, in the meantime, I cannot delay sending out an MFR for this information. I just wanted to let you know that we haven't forgotten your comments.
