

**MEMORANDUM FOR THE RECORD**

**SUBJECT: 18BON22 MFR – Adult Fish Facility Pacific Lamprey Mortality.**

On the morning of 28 June, University of Idaho technicians contacted Project Fisheries to alert them of (1) Pacific Lamprey mortality. The fish was tagged on the afternoon of 27 June, and was found dead in its holding tank on the morning of 28 June.

- A. Species – Pacific Lamprey (*Entosphenus tridentatus*).
- B. Origin – AFF trap
- C. Length – 65 cm
- D. Marks and tags – A tag was implanted, but then removed after mortality.
- E. Marks and Injuries found on carcass – The fish was found to have one gill pore on its left side that was larger than the others, but this was not suspected to be connected to its death.
- F. Cause and Time of Death – Night of 27-28 June.
- G. Future and Preventative Measures – None.
